	Pre-listening Activity (5 minutes):	
	 Review vocabulary related to jobs and work. Introduce any new vocabulary terms that students may encounter during the listening activity. Engage students in a brief discussion about their dream jobs and why they are interested in those careers. 	
	Listening Activity (10 minutes):	
	 Play the audio recording of job-related conversations from the Cambridge Global English Book 6. 	



 Encourage students to listen carefully and take notes on key information such as job titles, responsibilities, and requirements. Pause the recording at intervals to check comprehension and ask questions about what students have heard. Play the recording again if necessary. 	
Post-listening Activities (10 minutes):	
 Distribute handouts with listening comprehension questions based on the audio recording. Allow students to work individually or in pairs to answer the questions. Review the answers as a class and address any misunderstandings or
